STUDY ABROAD: May include two courses (one 200-level and one 300-level literature; or one 300-level literature and one 300-level writing) from a semester-abroad program may count toward the major. A third course (200- or 300-level) from a full-year-abroad program may count.

* Secondary education students should take a variety of English, American, and African American literature. They are also encouraged to take a Shakespeare course. THA 214, 329, or 331 may serve as a substitute for one ENG literature course.
